



26th Annual Fort Wayne Canoe & Kayak Races Saturday June 19, 2010

A USCA Indiana Div. Sanctioned Indiana Points Race

You are invited to participate in the Fort Wayne Canoe & Kayak Races. All Races start and finish at Shoaff Park Boat Ramp, 6401 St. Joe Road, Fort Wayne, IN 46835 on the St. Joseph River. The Citizens Races are 40 to 50 minutes, and run a 5 mile, 2 loop course down stream to the St. Joe Center Road Bridge, then back up stream to the boat ramp.

All USCA Classes run an 11 mile course traveling down stream to the St. Joe Center Road Bridge, then up stream to the Mayhew Road Bridge, then turn and travel back down stream to the finish at Shoaff Park. Last year's times ranged from 1-1/2 to 2 hours.

The St. Joe River is deep in this area and will give you and your partner a good chance to test yourself against the best of the Midwest racers.
